Introduction

The Graduate School is pleased to present the annual Doctoral Placement Report. This report is compiled based on a survey conducted by the Graduate School for doctoral recipients from the 2005-2006 academic year (i.e., doctoral degrees awarded in August 2005, December 2005, and May 2006). The survey is distributed to Directors of Graduate Studies and major professors late in the fall semester of the academic year following graduation (Fall 2007 for this report), and the responses are collected from the programs during the subsequent spring term. The DGS and major professor are asked to identify the nature and location of each doctoral recipient's *first* position of employment upon graduation. Placement categories include Academic (Administration, Research, College and University Teaching), Post-Doctoral, Business and Industry, Government, or other.

The Doctoral Placement Report is divided into two sections. The first section contains a disciplinary profile of our doctoral graduates as well as tables and figures that summarize doctoral placement for all graduates, including specific tables for Kentucky residents and international degree recipients. The second section provides a comprehensive listing detailing the job placement of all doctoral degree recipients arranged by the nature of the job placement and graduate program.

As you review this report, I am sure that you will be impressed by the broad range of employment secured by our doctoral graduates and the impact that they are making and will continue to make throughout the academic community, business and industry, and government. I encourage you to share this report with your unit faculty and staff, and other interested parties. Highlights

- The University of Kentucky produced 243 doctoral graduates during the 2005-2006 academic year. Of these 80 (32.92%) were in Biological Sciences, 29 (11.93%) were in the Humanities, 2 (0.82%) were in Medical Center Clinical Services, 55 (22.63%) were in the Physical and Engineering Sciences, and 77 (31.69%) were in the Social Sciences. See Tables 9.1 and 9.2 for further details.
- Of the 243 doctoral recipients, 51 (21.0%) accepted employment in Kentucky, 87 (35.8%) obtained employment elsewhere in the United States, 17 (7.0%) doctoral recipients were employed outside of the U.S., and 88 (36.2%) doctoral recipients' place of employment is unknown. See Tables 4.1 and 4.2 for further details.
- Of the 243 doctoral recipients, 82 (33.7%) accepted academic positions, 33 (13.6%) accepted post-doctoral positions, 26 (10.7%) accepted positions in business and industry, 11 (4.5%) accepted government or military positions, and 85 (35.0%) doctoral recipients' job classification is unknown. See Tables 4.1 and 4.3 for further details.
- Of the 243 doctoral recipients, 87 (35.8%) were awarded to Kentucky residents. Of these 87 Kentucky residents, 37 (42.5%) accepted academic positions, 10 (11.5%) accepted post-doctoral positions, 2 (2.3%) accepted positions in business and industry, 3 (3.4%) accepted government or military positions, and 33 (37.9%) Kentucky doctoral recipients' job classification is unknown. See Tables 5.1 and 5.3 for further details.
- Of the 243 doctoral recipients, 117 (48.1%) were awarded to women. Of these 117 female doctoral recipients, 38 (32.5%) accepted academic positions, 20 (17.1%) accepted post-doctoral positions, 8 (6.8%) accepted positions in business and industry, 8 (6.8%) accepted government or military positions, and 39 (33.3%) female doctoral recipients' job classification is unknown. See Tables 6.1 and 6.3 for further details.
- Of the 243 doctoral recipients, 72 (29.6%) were awarded to international students. Of these 72 international doctoral recipients, 19 (26.4%) accepted academic positions, 11 (15.3%) accepted post-doctoral positions, 14 (19.4%) accepted positions in business and industry, 1 (1.4%) accepted government or military positions, and 26 (36.1%) international doctoral recipients' job classification is unknown. See Tables 7.1 and 7.3 for further details.
- Of the 243 doctoral recipients, 23 (9.5%) were awarded to minorities. Of these 23 minority doctoral recipients, 7 (30.4%) accepted academic positions, 1 (4.3%) accepted post-doctoral positions, 1 (4.3%) accepted positions in business and industry, 4 (17.4%) accepted government or military positions, and 10 (43.5%) minority doctoral recipients' job classification is unknown.
