Nominee must be a UK senior (having graduated at the end of the 2009 Fall Semester, or expecting to graduate at the end of the 2010 Spring Semester or the 2010 Second Summer Session). Candidates may not have been previously enrolled in a graduate or professional program.

In the following order, the nomination packet must include **five** complete sets of:

1. A completed fellowship nomination form specific to the Matthews/Singletary/ Wethington Fellowships
2. Letter from the student's college advisor stating when all baccalaureate degree requirements are expected to be completed (if such is not already the case)
3. Photocopy of letter of acceptance to a graduate or professional program at UK (if such is already available)
4. Three letters of recommendation, of which at least two must be from University of Kentucky professors. These letters do **NOT** have to be in sealed envelopes. The letters should clearly indicate they are for the Matthews/Singletary/Wethington Fellowship nominations and should be submitted as part of the nomination packet, if at all possible
5. Candidate's personal statement (not to exceed two double-spaced pages) relating to career goals and providing evidence of participation and leadership roles in University and community life during the undergraduate years of study
6. Resume, including awards and honors, voluntary activities, and employment

Please note, these items may be sent electronically by email to grad.fellowships@uky.edu. These documents need to be received by the due date posted below. Please note the student's name and the name of the fellowship in the subject line of your email (only one copy of each item is necessary if submitted by email).

The Graduate School will provide the following documents to the selection committee on behalf of the department, on behalf of the applicant, in addition to the submitted nomination packet (you do not need to submit these items):

1. Official GRE or GMAT scores (if you are a professional student, please submit a copy of your LSAT, DAT, or MCAT scores)
2. Transcripts from all schools attended, both undergraduate and graduate
3. Copy of application submitted for admission to a graduate or professional program at UK
