For nearly 150 years, Kentucky's flagship and land grant research university has shined a bright path to prosperity for the Commonwealth it serves by providing a comprehensive academic experience that prepares students to lead lives of meaning and purpose; conducting cutting-edge research that addresses the relevant questions of our day; and rendering sophisticated care and meaningful service.

Over the last 13 years, the "Bucks for Brains" partnership between UK's Research Challenge Trust Fund and the Commonwealth of Kentucky has been a key component in supporting the innovations made by our faculty, staff and students. Since its inception, Kentucky has pledged more than \$230 million in state funds to UK, which we matched – dollar for dollar – with private funds to support the research enterprise of our institution. We've used these funds:

- As part of the effort to build the University's endowment from \$420.8 million in Fiscal Year 2001 to more than \$1.0 billion in Fiscal Year 2014.
- To create more than 300 endowed chairs and professorships across all colleges and professional schools; more than 260 fellowships, scholarships, and endowments for research support; and for the William T. Young Library.
- As a key element of increasing our external grants and contracts from \$173.6 million in Fiscal Year 2001 to more than \$259.3 million in Fiscal Year 2014.
- And, to open state-of-the-art research space in the College of Pharmacy and Davis Marksbury Building through increased flexibility with "Bucks for Bricks" revenue.

The benefits of this partnership – spanning more than a decade – are fulfilling our commitment to Kentucky. With your help, we have catapulted our institution to new heights, including:

- The Markey Cancer Center being named one of the 68 NCI-designated centers in the US.
- UK being among 22 universities with the triple-crown of federal research awards: NCI-designation, a Clinical and Translational Sciences Award, and an Alzheimer's Disease Center.
- An intent focus on multi-disciplinary, team-based research to confront the health maladies that afflict the people of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

FOCUS ON FACULTY



Vivek M. RangnekarAlfred Cohen Chair in Oncology Research

Vivek Rangnekar serves and the associate director of transdisciplinary collaboration at the Markey Cancer Center—Kentucky's only NCI-designated cancer center—and co- leads the center's cell biology & signaling research program. Rangnekar earned his Ph.D. from the University of Bombay and conducted postdoctoral training at the University of Chicago, before coming to UK in 1992. His team studies the molecular crosstalk between oncogenes (genetic material that has the ability to produce cancer) and tumor suppressor genes. His strategy is to utilize the inherent strengths of the tumor against itself, to specifically target cell survival mechanisms that are common to many different types of cancer. Rangnekar focuses on the multi-faceted tumor suppressor protein Par-4/PAWR, which he first identified in 1993. He says what makes Par-4 so special is that it is not mutated as frequently as other known suppressors, and Par-4 will only kill cancer cells and not normal cells. Par-4 can become "suppressed" or inactivated, leading to tumor re-growth, but Par-4 can be activated again—and one of the next major steps is developing a safe and effective way to activate Par-4 in cancerous cells. With funding from the National Cancer Institute, Rangnekar's team is looking at natural and synthetic agents that may help restore the expression of Par-4

in human cells, allowing the cancerous cells to become susceptible to treatment. Several UK investigators are now examining the role of Par-4 in chronic lymphocytic leukemia and aggressive brain tumors called glioblastomas, as well as developing small molecules that can activate Par-4 and kill cancer cells. "Our multi-disciplinary team, working together, uses a multi-faceted strategy in our research," Rangnekar says. "This allows us to gain a better understanding of the complexities of cancer in order to effectively kill recurrent tumor cells, especially those that have spread."



Diane FollingstadWomen's Circle Endowed Chair

Diane Follinstad is a professor in the UK College of Medicine Department of Psychiatry. Her expertise is in clinical and forensic psychology and she is director of the Center for Research on Violence Against Women (CRVAW). Follingstad's research has resulted in 85 journal articles and a book, and her recent work has focused on comparing different methods of assessing how decisions are made to prosecute battered women who have killed their partner, to illustrate how less conscious biases impact these decisions. Follingstad says, "Probably my most significant contribution has been both research and commentary designed to enhance the measurement of psychological abuse, which has been a difficult concept to measure." She is currently a PI with CRVAW colleague Ann Coker to evaluate the long-term effects of a bystander intervention program called Green Dot conducted in Kentucky high schools to identify difference in students who attend college and those who do not. "With Dr. Coker, we have almost completed a project that looks at the impact on women's treatment and recovery from cancer when partners engage interfering/controlling behaviors or intimate partner abuse, and we are extending this concept in a new grant proposal to look at partner impact on both women and men with colorectal cancer." Another proposed study, with Claire Renzetti, involves testing an online educational intervention to determine whether nursing personnel improve in their identification of sex trafficking cases. The strength of CRVAW lies in its multidisciplinary team, say Follingstad. "Our endowed faculty consist of an epidemiologist, a sociologist/

criminologist, and two psychologists, but we regularly end up working with a biostatistician and other faculty from social work, psychiatry, psychology, and communications. There is no question that our final research products are greatly improved by the involvement of faculty from a range of disciplines." The center is also working on new mechanisms for research training for postdoctoral fellows, graduate students and undergraduate students.



Nancy Harrington
Douglas A. and Carole A. Boyd Professor in Communication

Nancy Harrington is a professor in the College of Communication and Information, where she serves as associate dean for research. She holds a joint appointment in the College of Public Health. Harrington has been a principal investigator, coinvestigator, or principal evaluator on several NIH- funded and CDC-funded studies totaling approximately \$8.5 million. She's published more than 50 scholarly journal articles and chapters, and served as guest editor for a special issue, focused on communication strategies to reduce health disparities, of the *Journal of Communication*, the flagship journal of the International Communication Association. Harrington says, "Analyzing messages helps us understand how to design them to most effectively provide people the health information they need to make good decisions regarding health promotion and disease prevention behaviors. Subtle changes in the content, format, and structure of messages can have an impact on whether or not people pay attention to them, process them, and are informed or persuaded by them." Harrington is currently working on a text-based messaging system for patients to communicate with their based messaging system for patients to

communicate with their healthcare providers after they've been discharged from the hospital. "The system was developed with an NSF grant to Dan O'Hair and Derek Lane. We're proposing to partner with colleagues from UK Healthcare to test the intervention's effectiveness in reducing hospital readmission rates." UK has an outstanding reputation in health communication for two reasons, says Harrington: "Our faculty has been associated with projects that have brought more than \$50 million to UK. We've been one of the most highly funded communication departments in the nation. A second reason is our biennial Kentucky Conference on Health Communications (KCHC). Since it began in 1989, KCHC has grown into an internationally recognized venue for researchers, practioners, and students from health communication and other health-related sciences to present cutting-edge research. The conference has really put Kentucky on the map."



Jon Thorson

UK Chandler Medical Center Endowed Chair in Pharmaceutical Research and Innovation

Jon Thorson is a professor of pharmaceutical sciences, director of the Center for Pharmaceutical Research and Innovation (CPRI), and also serves in co-director roles for the Markey Cancer Center and the Center for Clinical and Translational Science. Thorson holds 23 patents and his area of expertise is natural products—molecules that have evolved for function over time. "Examples with anticancer activity include the microbial toxins calicheamicin and esperamicin. These natural products were first reported as I was starting graduate school, and I wrote what was presumably a very naive research proposal on the synthesis/biosynthesis of these molecules as a requirement for one of my Ph.D. courses. In an interesting twist of fate, the study of calicheamicin biosynthesis became one of the two main projects in my lab when I launched my independent career at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center roughly a decade later." Thorson explains that instead of synthesizing new molecules through complex chemistry, if you can manipulate the natural machinery that generates useful molecules you can speed up the process of drug development. Thorson's team is isolating new natural products from the Commonwealth for the "UK Natural Products Repository" (which contains 133 bacterial intellectual

property, as well as advancing science into, and through, clinical evaluation." natural products isolated from subterranean and mining-associated environments via collaboration with the Center for Applied Energy Research, the Kentucky Geologic Survey, U.S. Coal, and the Kentucky Division of Abandoned Mine Lands) and the "UK Synthetics Collection" (which contains 556 compounds including natural product mimics, modified natural products, and synthetic intermediates/fragments). The goal of these collections is to share promising compounds with researchers at UK to screen for new activities. Thorson says, "In 2.5 years, CPRI has engaged in 26 projects with UK investigators and four additional external projects with pharma and other academic institutions, where we have focused on building preliminary data to support new grant applications and intellectual property, as well as advancing science into, and through, clinical evaluation."

FOCUS ON STUDENTS

The Endowment Match Program is not only a mechanism to recruit faculty, it also provides research opportunities and financial support for some of the most talented graduate students in the U.S. In Fiscal Year 2014, the Endowment Match Program provided graduate fellowships to 657 recipients.

FOCUS ON KENTUCKY

Bucks for Brains is a primary catalyst for the substantial growth in external research funding to the University and the Commonwealth. Since the Kentucky General Assembly passed the Postsecondary Education Improvement Act of 1997 (House Bill 1), external research grants and contracts at the University have increased from \$122 million to \$259.3 million (a 113 percent increase). (www.research.uky.edu/numbers/stats.html).

During Fiscal Year 2014, external research grants and contracts resulted in a \$374.1 million contribution to the Kentucky economy, including \$201.4 million in personal income. Externally supported research accounted for 9,803 jobs at UK and throughout Kentucky. Each dollar of out-of-state external funding for research generates approximately \$1.90 of total related expenditures.

ENDOWMENT ACTIVITY

Since its creation, the University of Kentucky has received \$233,334,000 in state funds through the Research Challenge Trust Fund for the Endowment Match Program and the Research Capital Match Program which was created by the 2008 Kentucky General Assembly to support research capital projects. Pursuant to its statutory authority, the University of Kentucky Board of Trustees allocated \$21,926,570 to the Research Capital Match Program and the remaining funds have been dedicated to the Endowment Match Program. Per the Program Guidelines for both the Endowment Match Program and the Research Capital Match Program all state funds have been fully matched by the University on a dollar-for-dollar basis.

Since 1998, the University of Kentucky has used the Endowment Match Program to:

- create 93 endowed chairs and 213 endowed professorships; and
- create 264 fellowships, enrichments and mission support projects to support research and the William T. Young Library (Table 1).

ENDOWMENT MATCH PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

Endowment Match Program faculty have made substantial contributions to the University of Kentucky research portfolio. As of June 30, 2014, UK has 315 total active patents, primarily in drug development and drug design; plant biotech; equine health; medical implants; drug delivery systems; and medical devices. Thirty new patents were issued and 23 patent applications were filed in Fiscal Year 2014. UK received \$3.3 million in licensing revenue, held a total of 124 licenses, and issued 11 new licenses, six of which were to UK start-up companies. According to the 2013 report from AUTM, the Association of University Technology Managers, UK ranks 46th in start-up companies among all public universities. In addition, UK ranks 52th among all universities and 30th among all public universities in total licensing income.

DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

As of June 30, 2014, the University of Kentucky has appointed a total of 203 faculty endowed chairs and professorships under the auspices of the Endowment Match Program. Of those appointments, 165 (81.3 percent) are male, and 38 (18.7 percent) are female. Of the 807 research staff associated with the Bucks for Brains program, 373 (46.2 percent) are male and 434 (53.8 percent) are female (Table 2).

During Fiscal Year 2014 there were 127 endowments supporting graduate fellowships. Since a single endowment may support multiple student awards, 657 graduate students received support from endowment proceeds (Table 4). There were 260 (39.8 percent) minority students among fellowship recipients.

AREAS OF CONCENTRATION

The Council on Postsecondary Education's 2002-04 and 2008-10 Endowment Match Program Guidelines stipulate that at least 70 percent of program funds at the research institutions must be used to support Research Challenge programs or academic disciplines contained within Kentucky's five new economy clusters: (1) human health and development; (2) biosciences; (3) materials science and advanced manufacturing; (4) information technologies and communications; and (5) environmental and energy technologies. As shown below, the University of Kentucky directed 79.2 percent of the funds to support positions, programs, or projects within the new economy clusters (Table 5).

Pursuant to the 2002-04 and 2008-10 Endowment Match Program Guidelines, the University also directed at least 70 percent of program funds to support chairs, professorships or research scholars, and infrastructure or fellowships directly linked to the research activities of endowed chairs and professors.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

The University has received all currently available state matching funds for the Endowment Match Program. The market value and accumulated fund balances as of June, 30, 2014, of all endowments created or expanded as part of the Endowment Match Program total \$523,648,483.
