Specifically, including but but not limited to, the officers are authorized to execute documents required by the U.S. Department of the Treasury, Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau.

Background: University of Kentucky researchers have been producing wine as part of UK's ongoing research efforts to help the state wine production industry. Research has been conducted
with the support of the Ag Development Board. To date, researchers have been disposing of the
wine after production. The Ag Development Board has directed UK to maximize program
income through a variety of efforts including selling this wine. To do so, UK has to have
appropriate permits from the state and federal government. CAFÉ has hired an external
consultant to advise on the process. As this is a research effort supported by grant support,
UKRF will hold the required permits. As part of the permitting process and based on
requirements of the United States Department of the Treasury, our external consultants have
advised that UKRF must expressly designate officers with signatory authority for this purpose.
Dr. Cassis will be asked to execute most documents that require a single signature.
