
IRC Application Process - Deadline: April 7, 2022

- Submit to: https://ris.uky.edu/pdo/fundingportal/
 - IRC cover letter
 - Abstract (30 lines maximum; Arial 11 pt font, minimum 0.5 inch margins)
 - Research plan (2 pages)
 - NIH-style biosketch or abbreviated CV for each investigator (5 pages maximum)
 - Budget/justification (1 page)
- Proposals will be reviewed by College ADRs or designates
- Progress report IRC symposium week
- Since the IRC conceptual framework is to generate <u>NEW</u> research ideas, applications to collect preliminary data in response to an extramural review committee critique are NOT eligible

IRC Proposal Eligibility


- Faculty from <u>all</u> UK colleges are invited to apply
- Previous IRC awardees are eligible to apply
- Faculty on previous IRC proposals are eligible to apply again, as long as they have no publications and no funding history together
- Faculty do not have to attend the networking event to be eligible for IRC funding
- Faculty can submit more than one application

Participating faculty per college 2014 - 2020






Number of pilots FUNDED per college 2014 - 2020






IRC funds \$ invested 2014 - 2022
