Gross necropsy exams, by a DLAR veterinarian, are available at no cost to researchers to evaluate unexpected morbidity or mortality in their animal colonies (natural or research-related). If you need to have a necropsy performed, please complete this form. Contact by phone or in person a DLAR veterinary technician or veterinarian found in DLAR Staff Contacts. Diagnostic evaluations are best when done as close to the time of death as possible to preserve tissues and diagnostic samples. **Refrigerate, Do Not Freeze Carcasses.**
