# Responsible Conduct in Research (RCR) training on the Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) Program


RCR training is a requirement for various funding opportunities. The University of Kentucky (UK) is a contributing member and subscriber to the web-based CITI training program, which provides on-line RCR training. Completion of the CITI RCR training meets the requirements set forth by the National Science Foundation (NSF) and National Institute of Food and Agriculture.

## **Instructions to access CITI Training Program to complete**

## Responsible Conduct in Research (RCR) training

The University of Kentucky (UK) is transitioning to CITI Single Sign On (SSO) access through the institution, using individuals' <u>UK Link Blue</u> account. **All UK employees and students are assigned a <u>Link Blue directory account</u> (user id). It is used to connect many campus-wide systems, including myUK, Exchange Email, Canvas, etc.** 

**STEP 1:** On the <u>UK Link Blue webpage</u>, click **CITI** to open the UK CITI portal.





Log in with your
UK Link Blue
User ID, (e.g., Xsmith99)
and Password.
Do not use ad\ or mc\


The User ID is typically around 6 letters from the user's name or initials along with a number.

# If you have a UK account on CITI, the portal will attempt to match your UK Link Blue with your CITI account.

- <u>If a match is found</u>, you will automatically be logged into CITI and land on the Main Menu page where you may check your CITI ID number or click "My Reports" to confirm that the match was accurate.
- If no match is found you can self-select your CITI account and match it to your UK Link Blue.


Click "I already have a CITI Program account" and enter your EXISTING CITI username and password in order for CITI to link your existing CITI program account to your UK Link Blue account. If you do not remember your CITI username or password contact the Office of Research Integrity (ORI) for assistance.


If you do NOT have a UK account on CITI, you may create one.

Click **Add a Course or Update Learner Groups** under the My Learner Tools for University of Kentucky menu. The UK CITI curriculum includes training to meet Institutional Review Board (IRB) requirements and RCR requirements. <u>Select the RCR course option</u>.

## **Choose Applicable RCR Course**


Choose the version of RCR training most applicable to your area of research.


